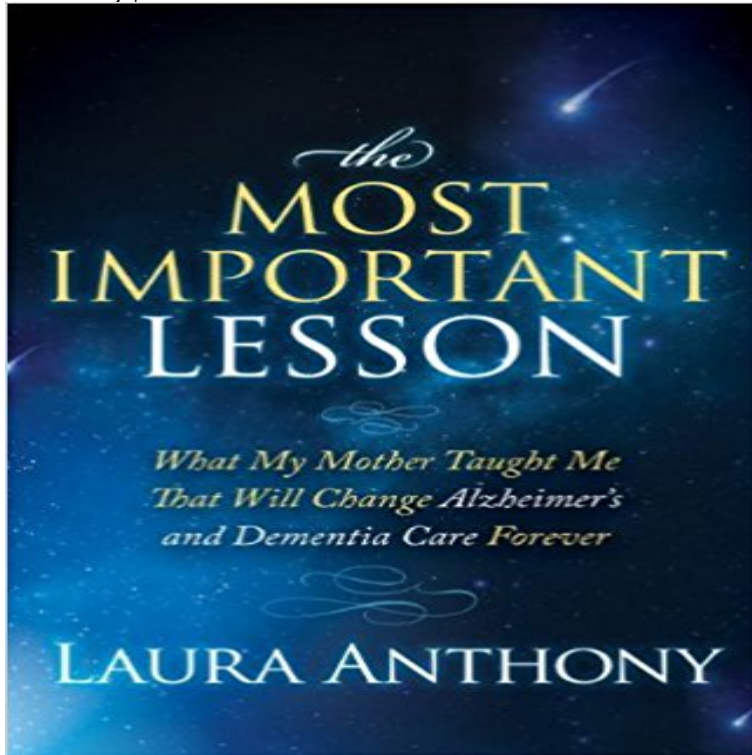


The Most Important Lesson: What My Mother Taught Me That Will Change Alzheimers and Dementia Care Forever
