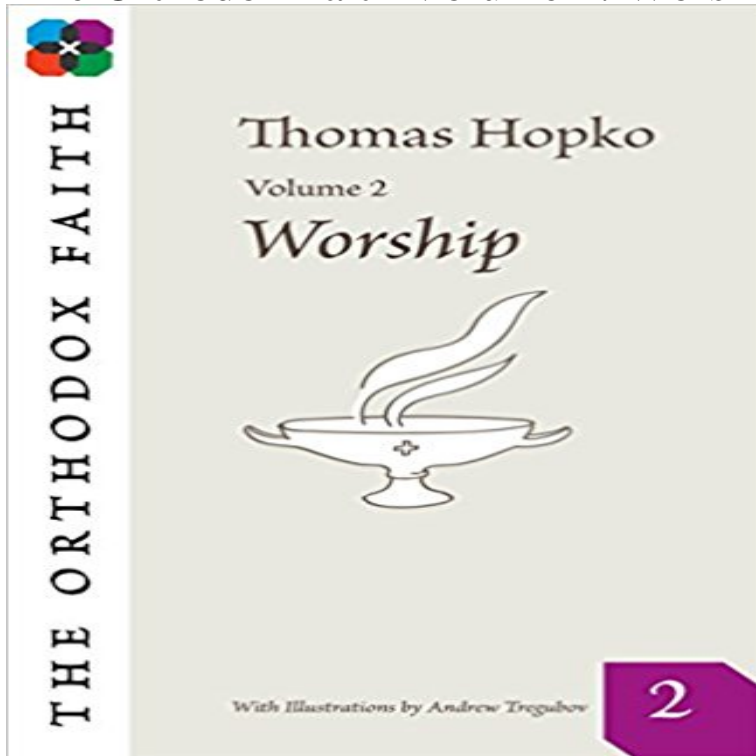


## The Orthodox Faith Volume 2: Worship
