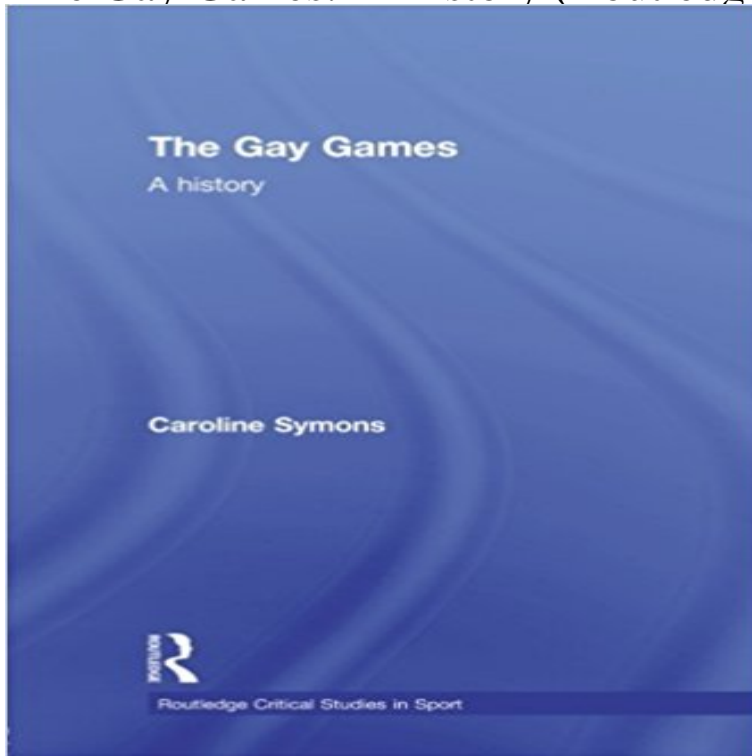


The Gay Games: A History (Routledge Critical Studies in Sport)
