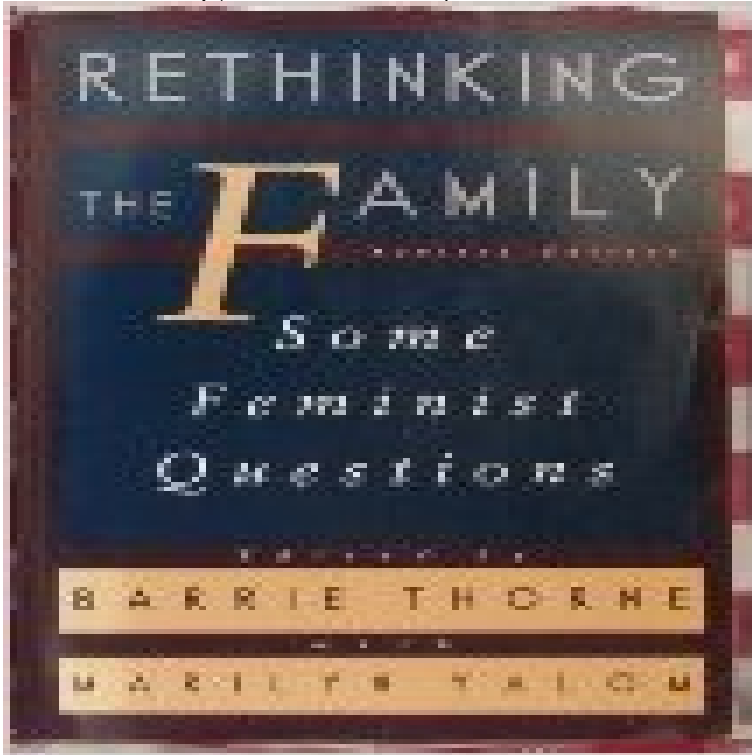


Rethinking The Family: Some Feminist Questions
