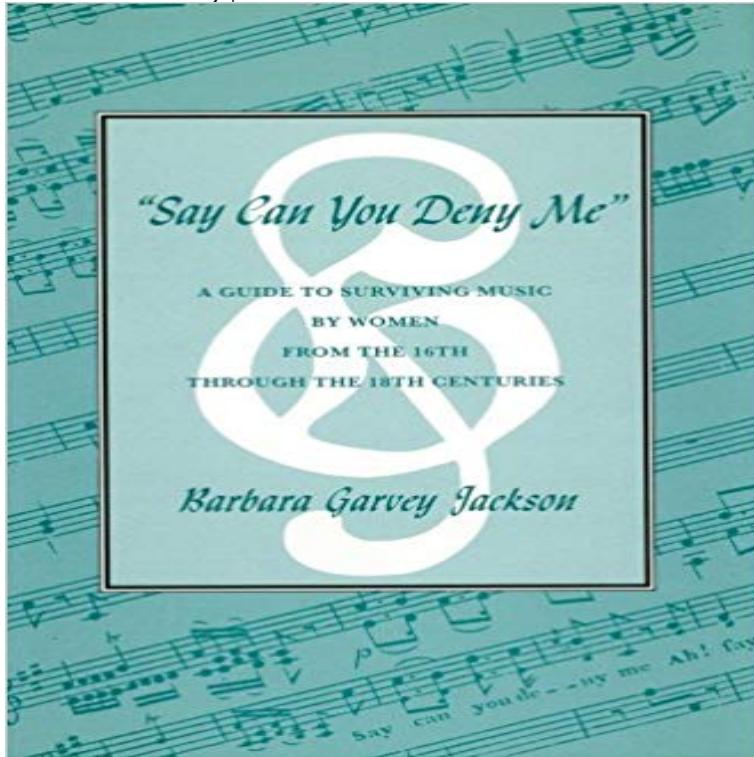


# Say Can You Deny Me: A Guide to Surviving Music by Women from the 16th through the 18th Centuries
