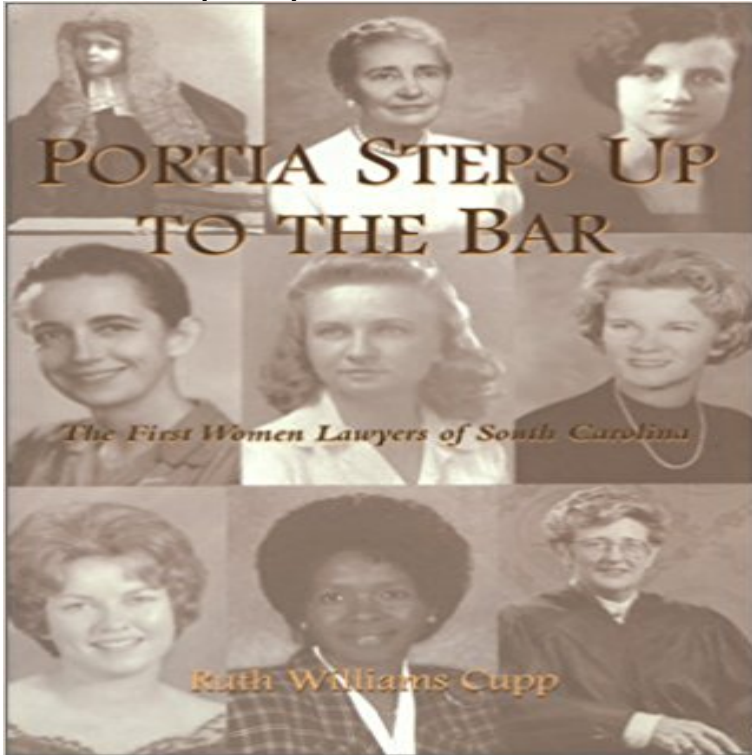


Portia Steps Up to the Bar: The First Women Lawyers of South Carolina
