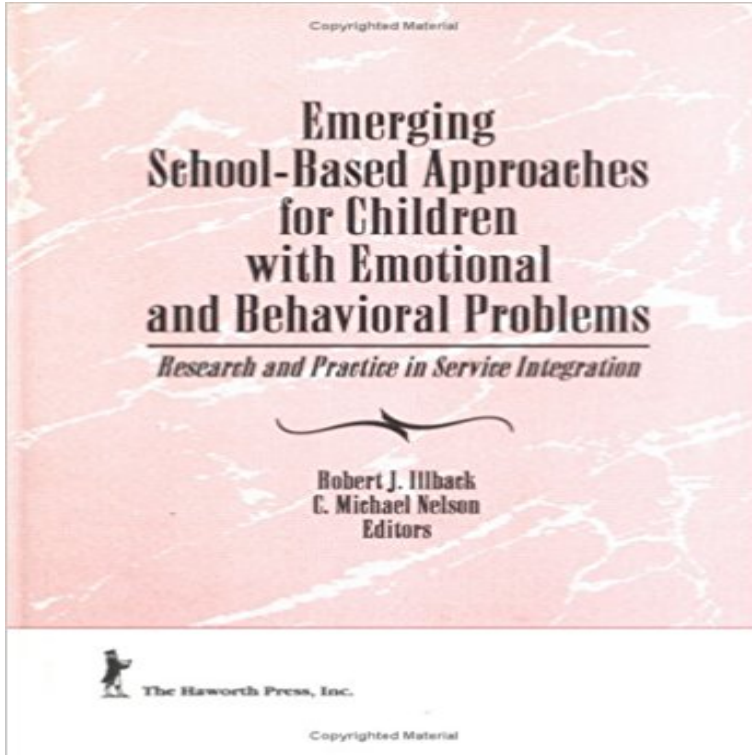


Emerging School-Based Approaches for Children With Emotional and Behavioral Problems: Research and Practice in Service Integration

Programs presented focus on the development of more broad-based community services, less restrictive child placement, prevention of hospitalization and out-of-home placement, interagency collaboration, flexible and individualized services, and cost

containment and efficiency.
