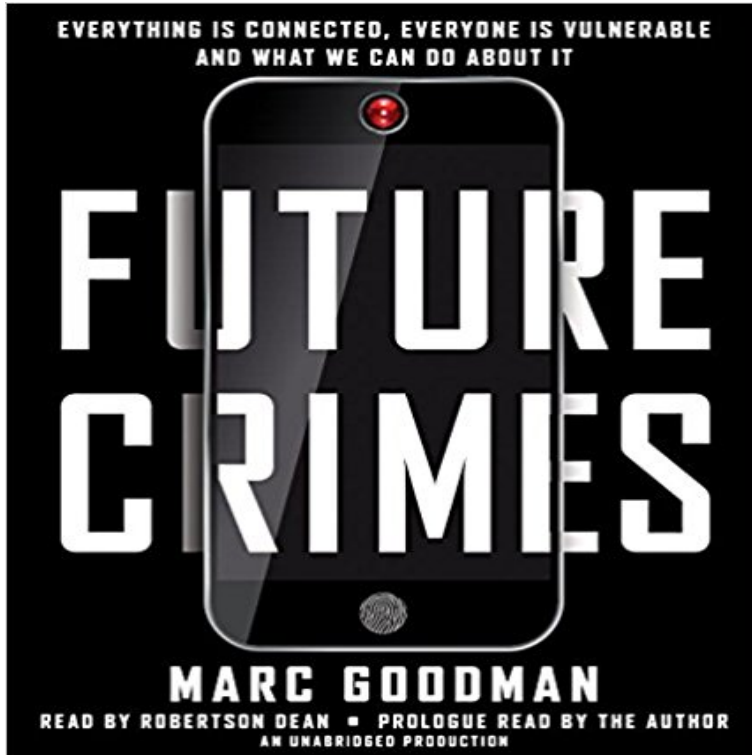


# Future Crimes: Everything Is Connected, Everyone Is Vulnerable and What We Can Do About It
