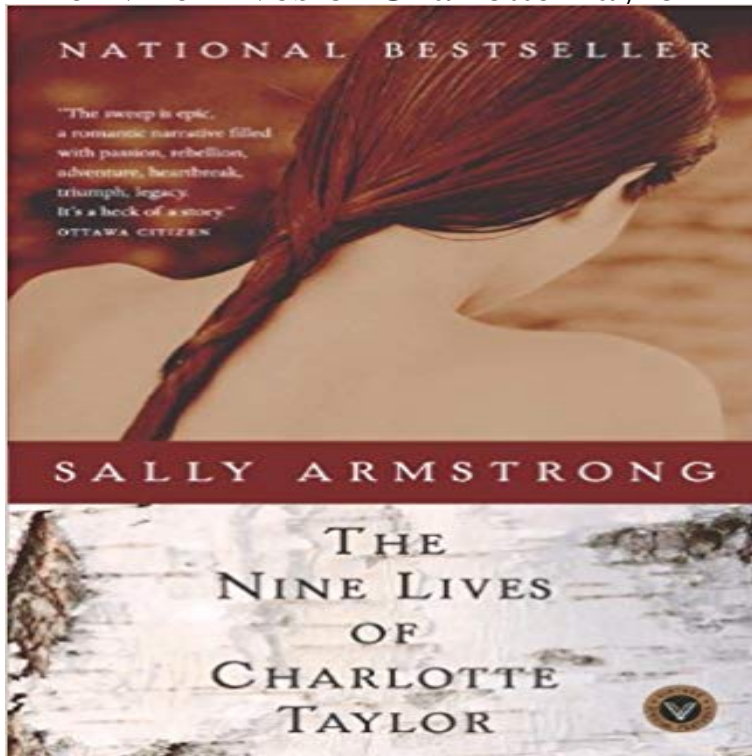


The Nine Lives of Charlotte Taylor

In the sixty-six years that followed, she would find refuge with the Mikmaq of what is present-day New Brunswick, have three husbands, nine more children and a lifelong relationship with an aboriginal man. She wasnt exactly presented as a gentlewoman, although it was said that she came from an aristocratic family in England. Nor was there much that seemed genteel about the person they always referred to as old Charlotte. Words like lover and land grabber drifted down from the supper table to where we kids sat on the floor. There were whoops of laughter at her indiscretions, followed by sideways glances at us. But for all the stories passed around, it was clear the family still had a powerful respect for a woman long dead. We owed our very existence to her, and the anecdotes the older generation told

suggested that their own fortitude and guile were family traits passed down from the ancestral matriarch. For as long as I can remember, I've tried to imagine the real life Charlotte Taylor lived and, more, how she ever survived. From the Trade Paperback edition.
