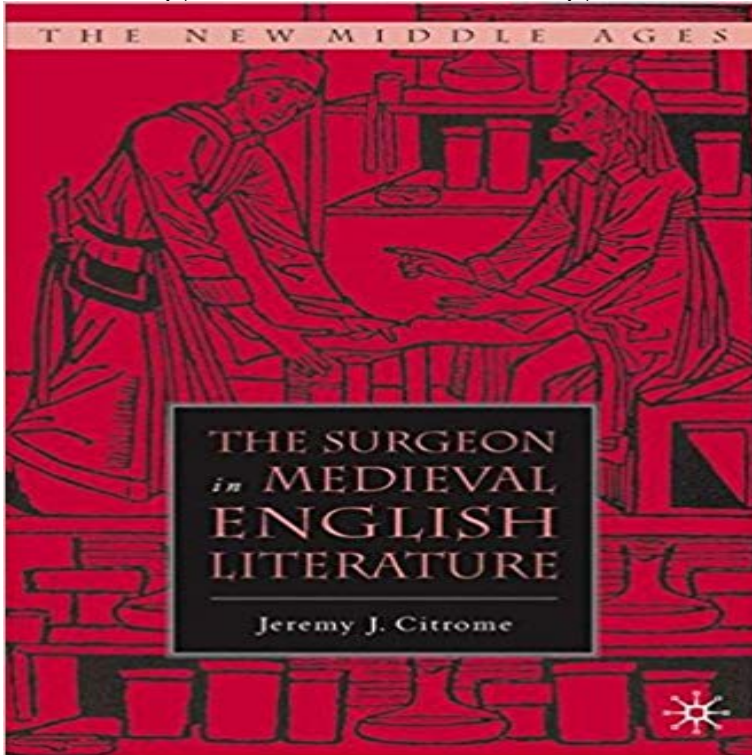


The Surgeon in Medieval English Literature (The New Middle Ages)
