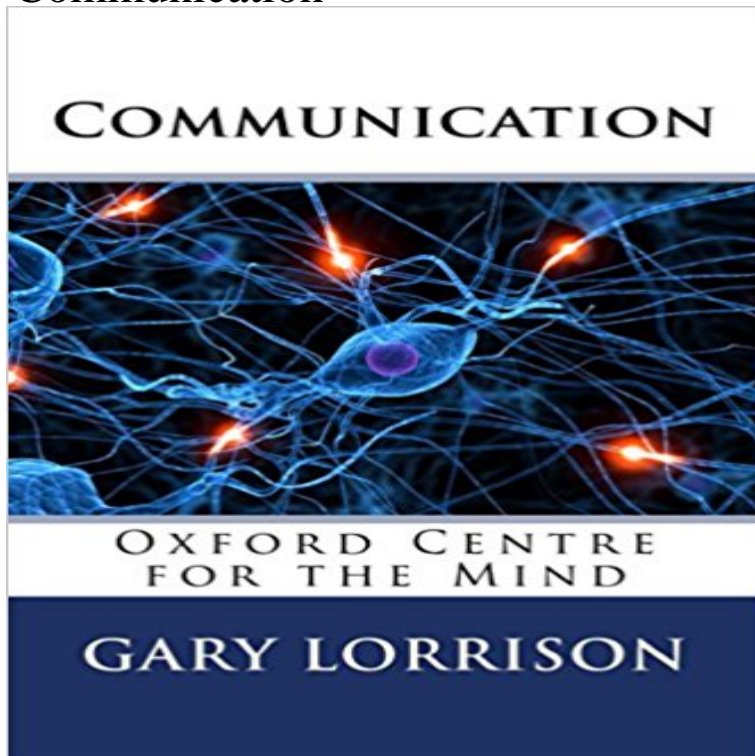


Communication
