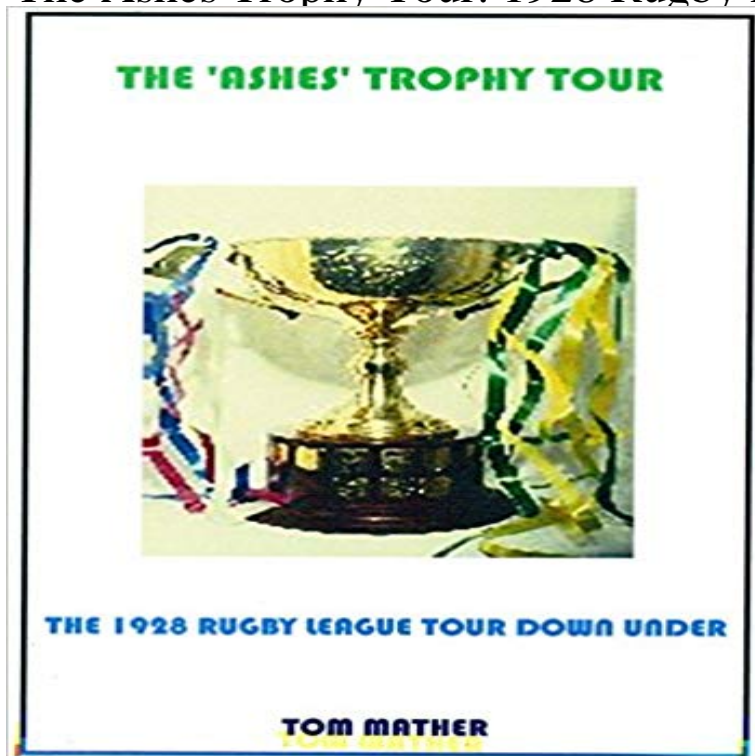


The Ashes Trophy Tour: 1928 Rugby League Tour Down Under

The tourists use the medium of radio for the first time to publicise events. Two brothers selected for the tour for the first and only time. An Ashes cup presented to the winners for the first time. It was to see the tourists win the series in both countries. On their return journey they would play the first ever professional rugby league game in Canada. The book details the important games played along with events that transpired off the field. Problems with the Queensland Authorities that almost saw the tour abandoned. Refereeing problems once again blight events particularly in New Zealand.
