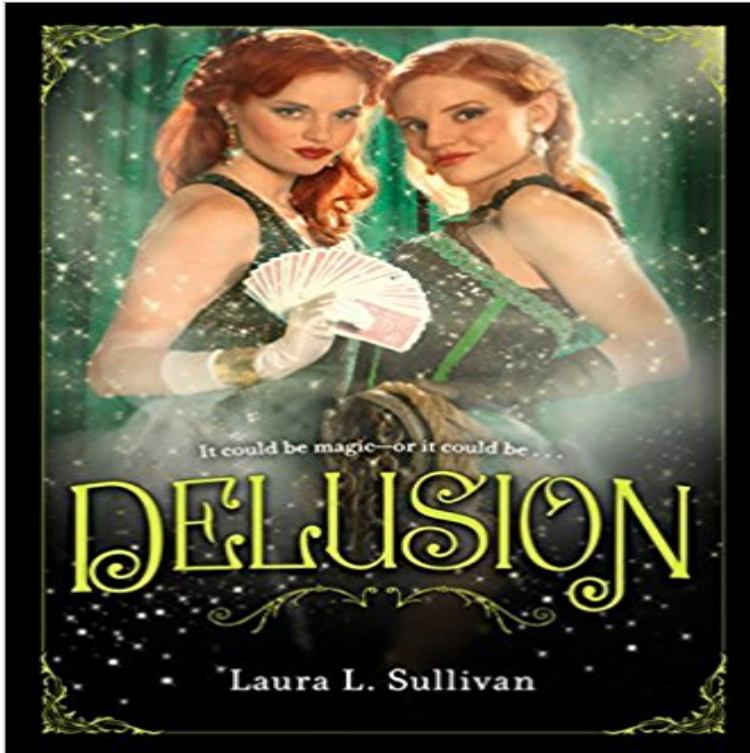


Delusion
