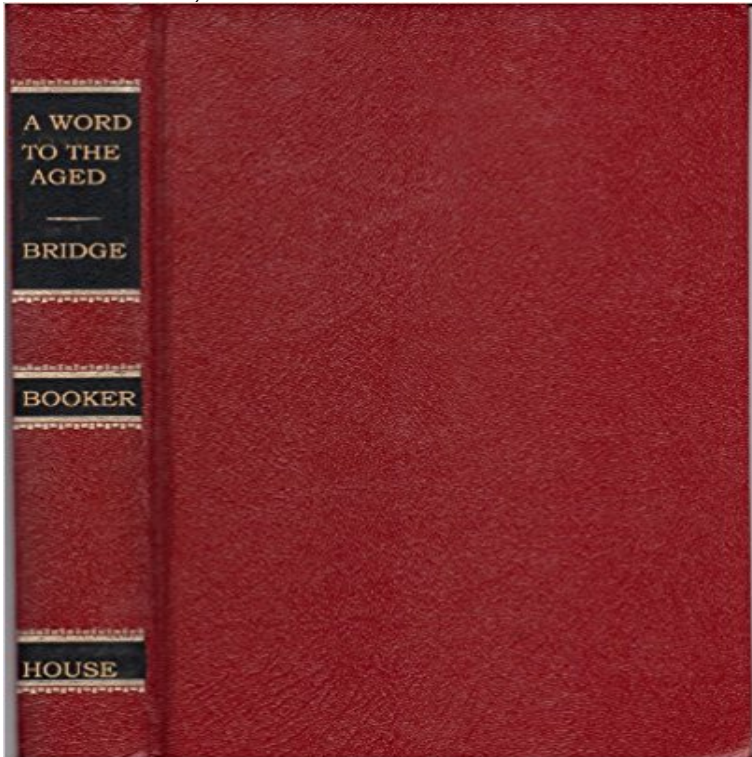


A WORD TO THE AGED: A 1667 DISCOURSE BY WILLIAM BRIDGE, Annotated.



Originally published in 1667, William Bridges sermon is current even in 2012. It speaks of specific sins to which the aged are most disposed: bitterness, impenitence, and a grumbling spirit. Looking to the Lord Jesus Christ as the therapy for the sins and maladies of old age, both mental and physical, Bridge tells the Christian how we may enhance our remaining years so that we may better glorify God and please Him. In addition, there is a short biography of William Bridge and commentary on the political events in England during Bridges lifetime.
