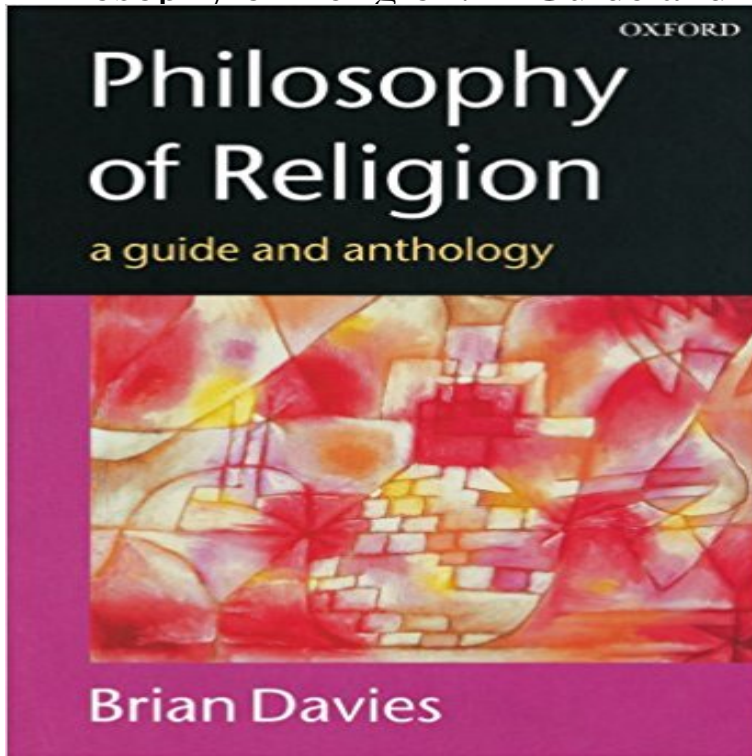


Philosophy of Religion: A Guide and Anthology
