James Braddock had fought on the undercard of the June 1934 World Heavyweight Championship fight between Primo Carnera and Max Baer. He was as much as a 10-1 underdog entering the fight with Baer in June 1935. My book includes a blow by blow, round by round account of a great fight between two fighters who have become legends over time. The champion was known for his right hand punch, especially his right uppercuts. The challengers left hand was a punch that deserved recognition by any opponent. As much fun to read as the fights progression are the reporters accounts that were written afterward. Many, if not most of them, were made fools of by the bouts outcome.

Max Baer Versus James Braddock World Heavyweight Boxing Madison Square Garden Bowl was the name of an outdoor arena in the New York City borough of Queens. Built in 1932, the arena hosted circuses and boxing matches. Its seating capacity was 72,000 spectators on wood bleachers. It was located at 48th Street and Northern Boulevard in Long Island City.
