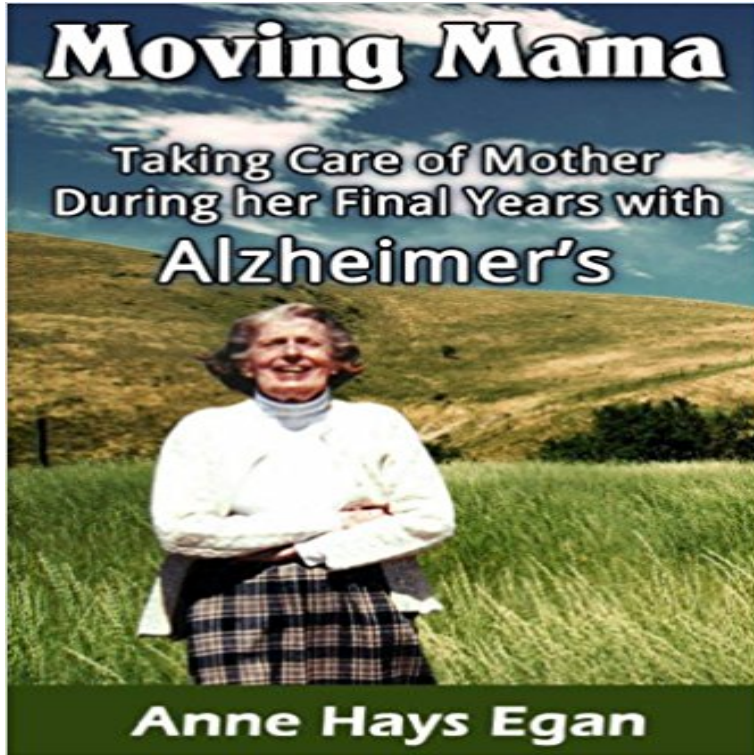


Moving Mama: Taking Care of Mother During Her Final Years with Alzheimers
